PJF Farm and Lodge, a conservation and recreation area at Cazan Lake, is nestled on approximately 4,000 acres of land seven miles north of Ville Platte, Louisiana.

From nature trails to secret passageways, explore our captivating views with a curated kayaking adventure, a hike off the beaten path, and a tranquil tour of our bird rookery during the spring season.

PJF Farm is home to spectacular seasonal wildlife communities associated with three major ecosystems and six distinct natural habitat types that commingle with approximately 1,600 acres of rice and crawfish production areas.
