

PHOTOGRAPHY GUIDELINES

The following guidelines have been established in an effort to keep the birds safe, secure, and comfortable in their nesting place. Adherence to the guidelines is required to maintain the right to visit the PJF Farm Rookery.

Photography membership includes only the rookery. You can hike the Lil' Bleu loop on foot only and you are welcome to kayak photograph in the 3 lakes, kayaks are not allowed in the rookery. The fields and the hunting club are both strictly prohibited. No vehicles past the restricted area sign.

- **Violation of any of the following guidelines will result in forfeiture of your membership/pass privileges.**
- **You will be required to vacate the property immediately.**
- **No refunds will be granted for forfeited memberships/passes due to a violation of any guidelines.**

- A. Photography and/or viewing hours are from sunrise to sunset, seven days a week. Be aware that roads to the rookery may be closed due to weather conditions. We suggest that you call before your arrival.
- B. No watercraft (boat, kayak, Jon boat, or other moveable floatation device) is allowed to be launched in or near the PJF Farm Rookery and/or beyond the marked, posted boundaries around the PJF Farm Rookery.
- C. Pets are prohibited near the PJF Farm Rookery during the rookery season.
- D. Discharging a firearm, loud music, yelling, cursing, or any other form of loud disruption is prohibited.
- E. Drones are not allowed at the PJF Farm Rookery or PJF Farm without PJF Farm Management approval.
- F. You must abide by all federal, local, state, and Louisiana Department of Wildlife & Fisheries laws while on the PJF Farm property.
- G. All trash must be removed and disposed of in the trash cans provided.
- H. All PJF Farm Rookery bird watching and photography must be done from land. The levee road cannot be blocked at any time.
- I. For your safety, as well as the safety of the birds, no one is allowed to enter the water at any time.

- J. Parking is only allowed in designated areas. NO parking on the levee road is allowed at any time.
- K. Do not feed the alligators nor any wildlife nor entice them to approach. This is their home and are not to be disturbed.
- L. For those purchasing a season pass, there is a \$25 replacement fee for the gate access card. Each photography pass holder is responsible for their own card and is to never be loaned out nor scanned to let others onto PJF Farm property.
- M. PJF Farm Rookery photographers or bird watchers are not allowed to bring nor ride ATV's, side by sides, nor any other all-terrain or recreational vehicles while on the property without PJF Farm Management approval.
- N. Hiking, walking trails, levees and fields are OFF LIMITS to vehicles.
- O. You are welcome to bring picnic baskets and/or ice chests for your enjoyment (please pick up all trash prior to your departure). A list of restaurants can be obtained at the Welcome Center should you want to venture out to enjoy our wonderful local foods.
